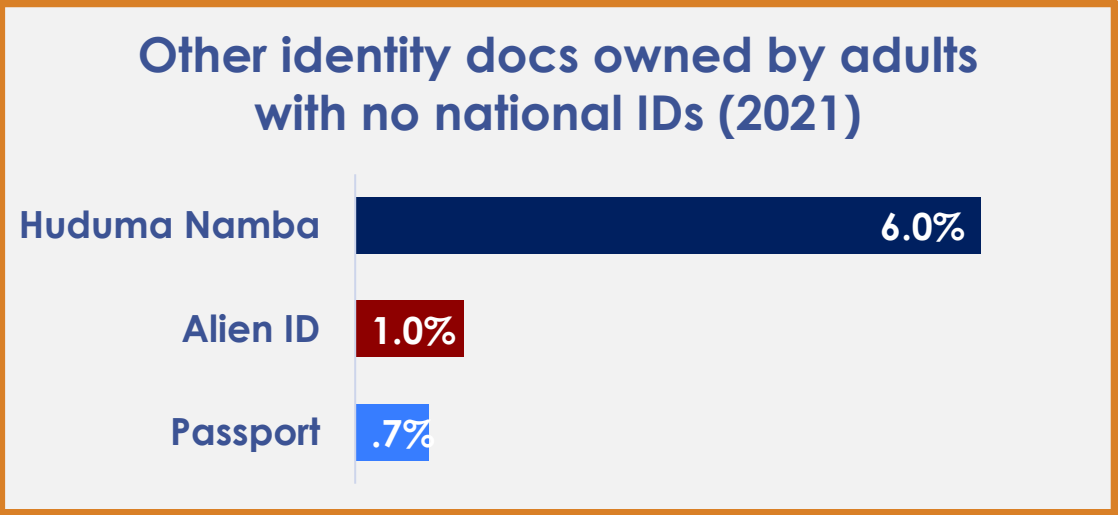
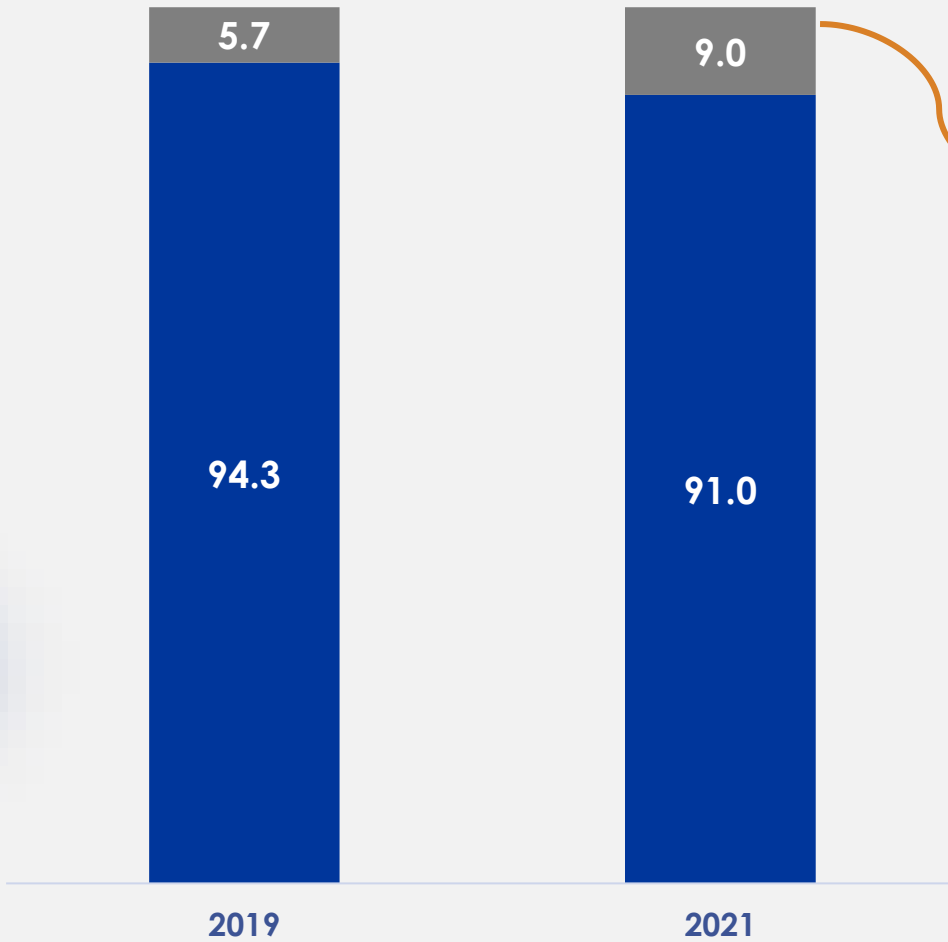
Identity card ownership (2021)

Ownership of IDs (%)

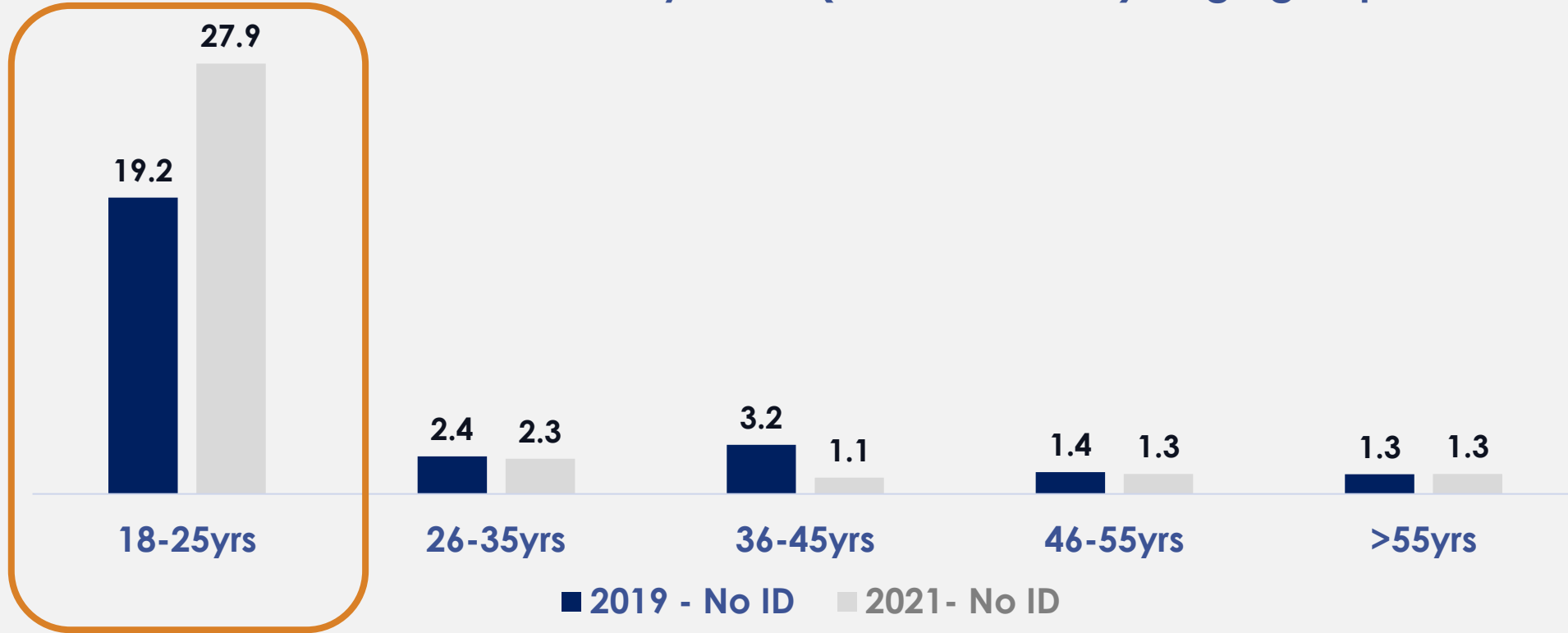


■ Adults with National ID ■ Adults with no National ID

Lack of National Identity cards (2019 and 2021) – age groups



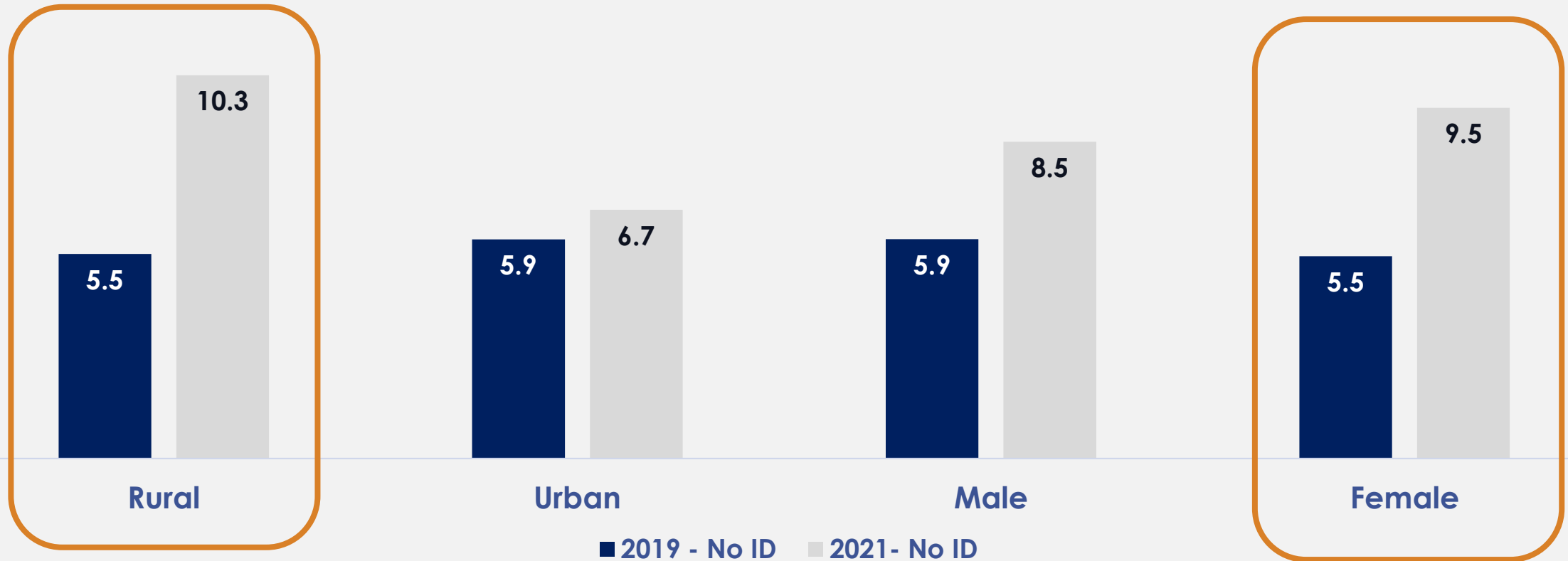

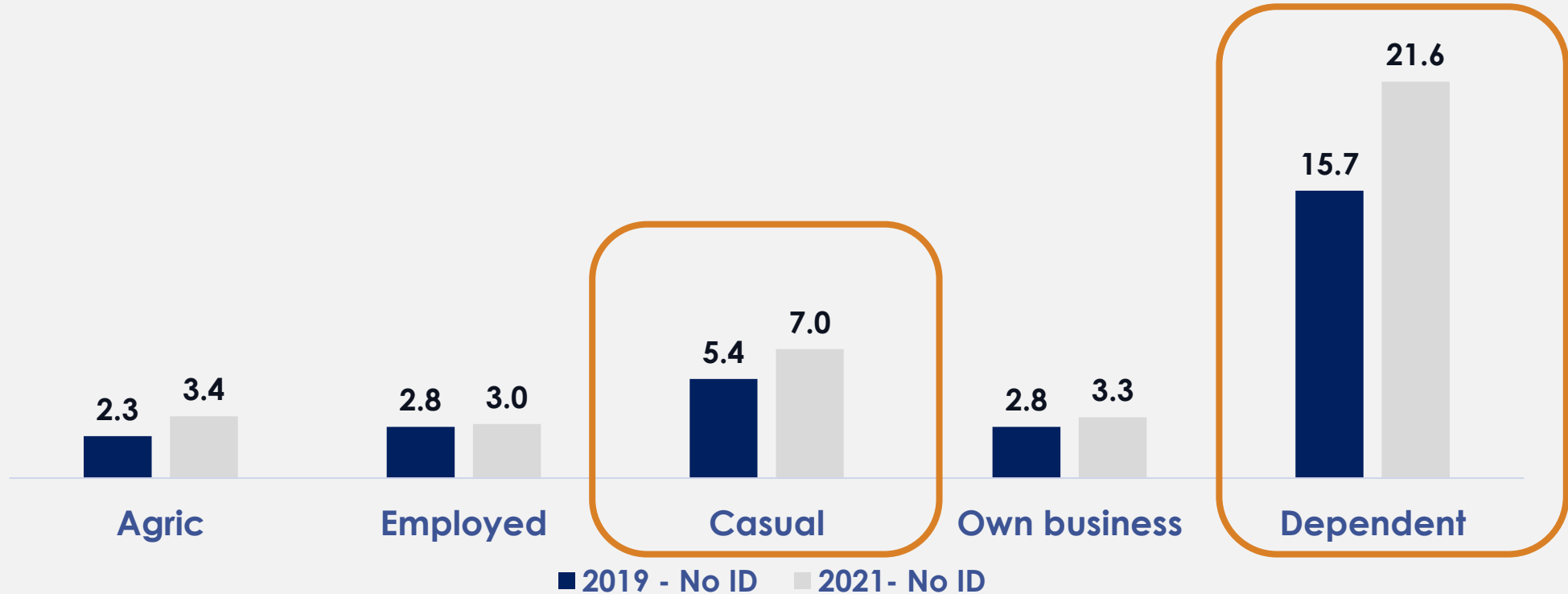
Highest incidence of lack of National identity cards in the rural areas & among women (& more than doubled since 2019)

Dependents and casual worker are the largest and growing livelihoods without IDs

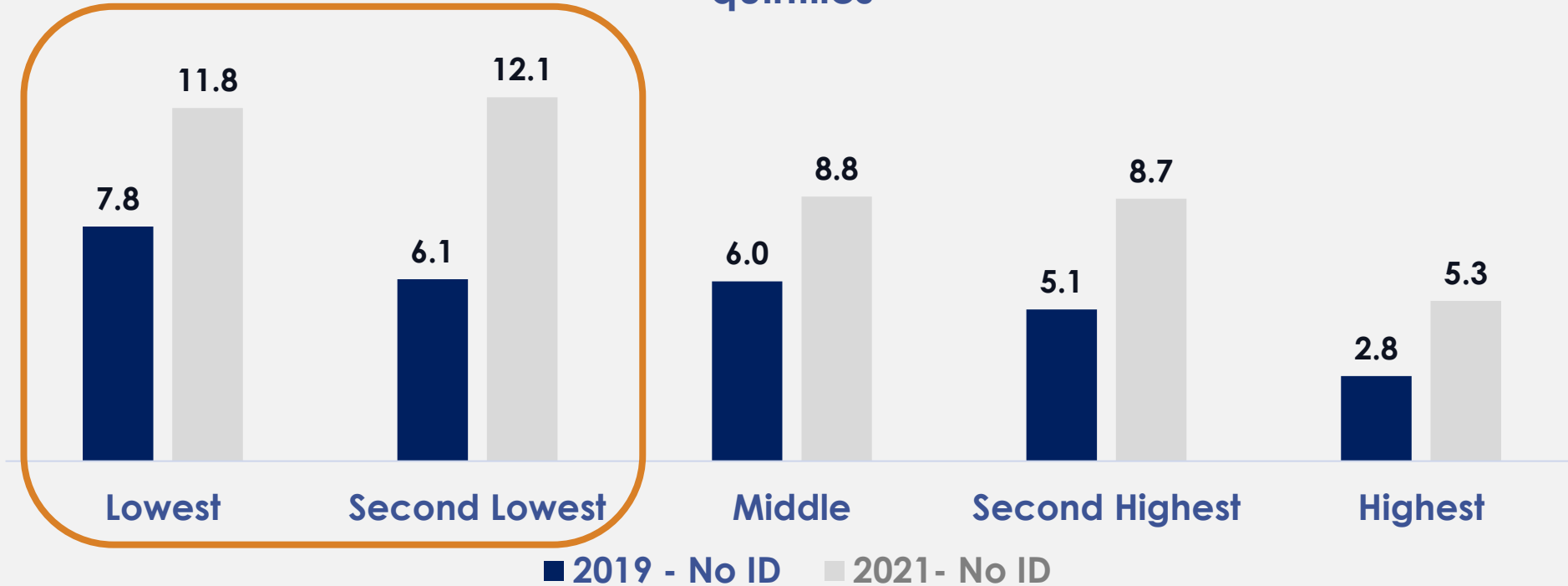
Lack of National Identity cards (2019 and 2021) – Livelihoods

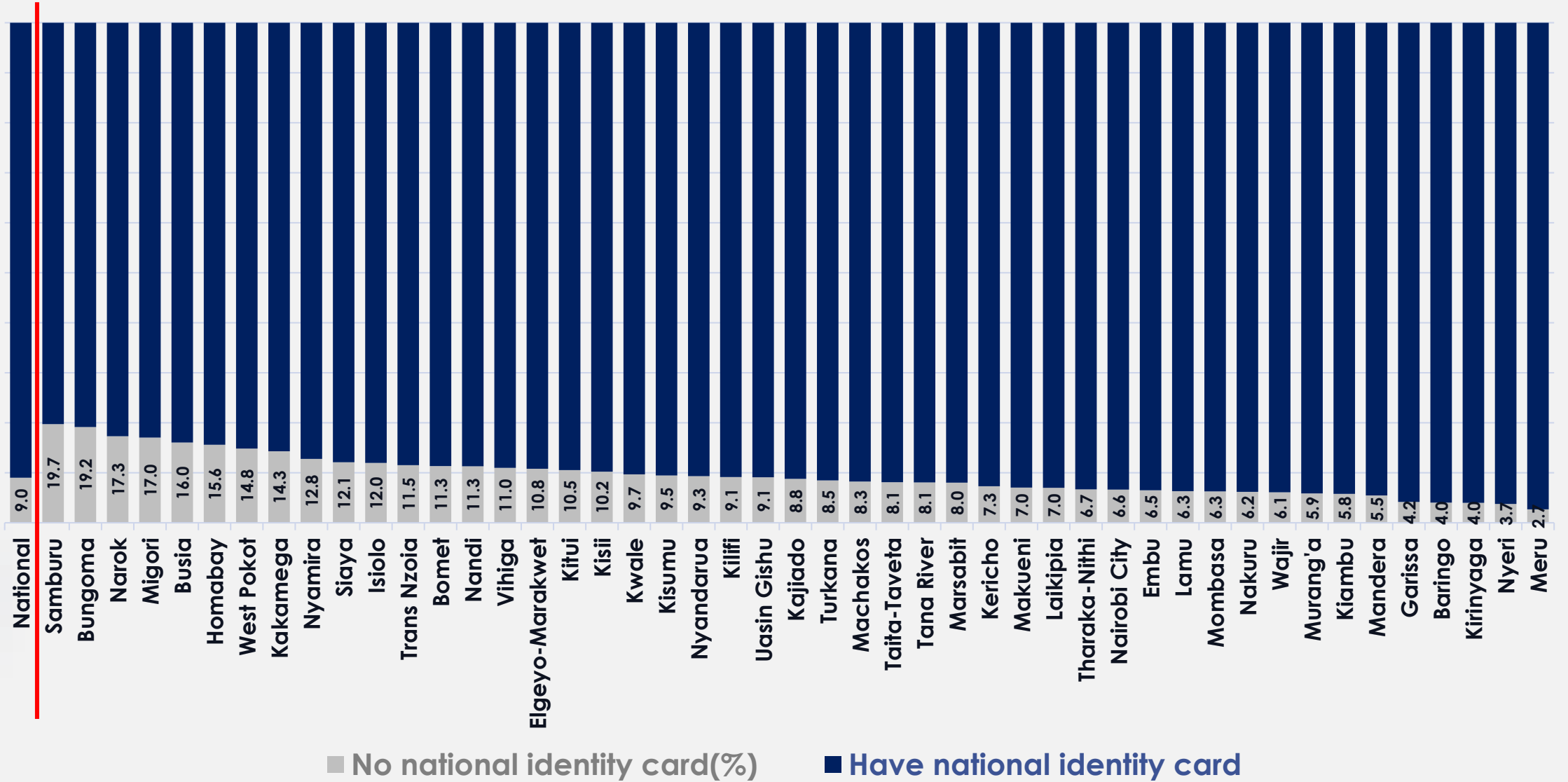
Decreased ID ownership across all quintiles but especially the bottom two

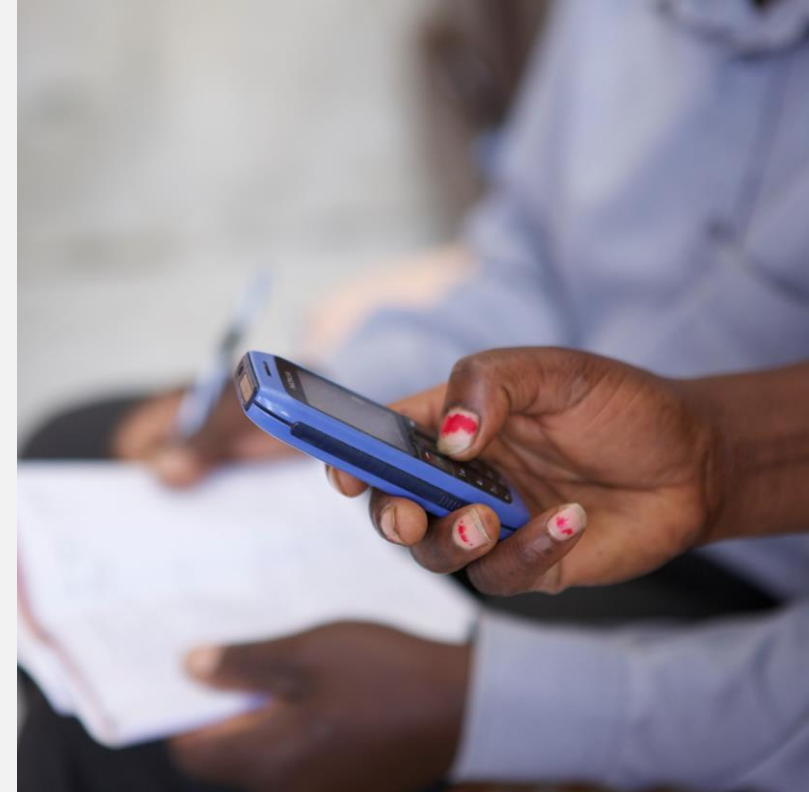
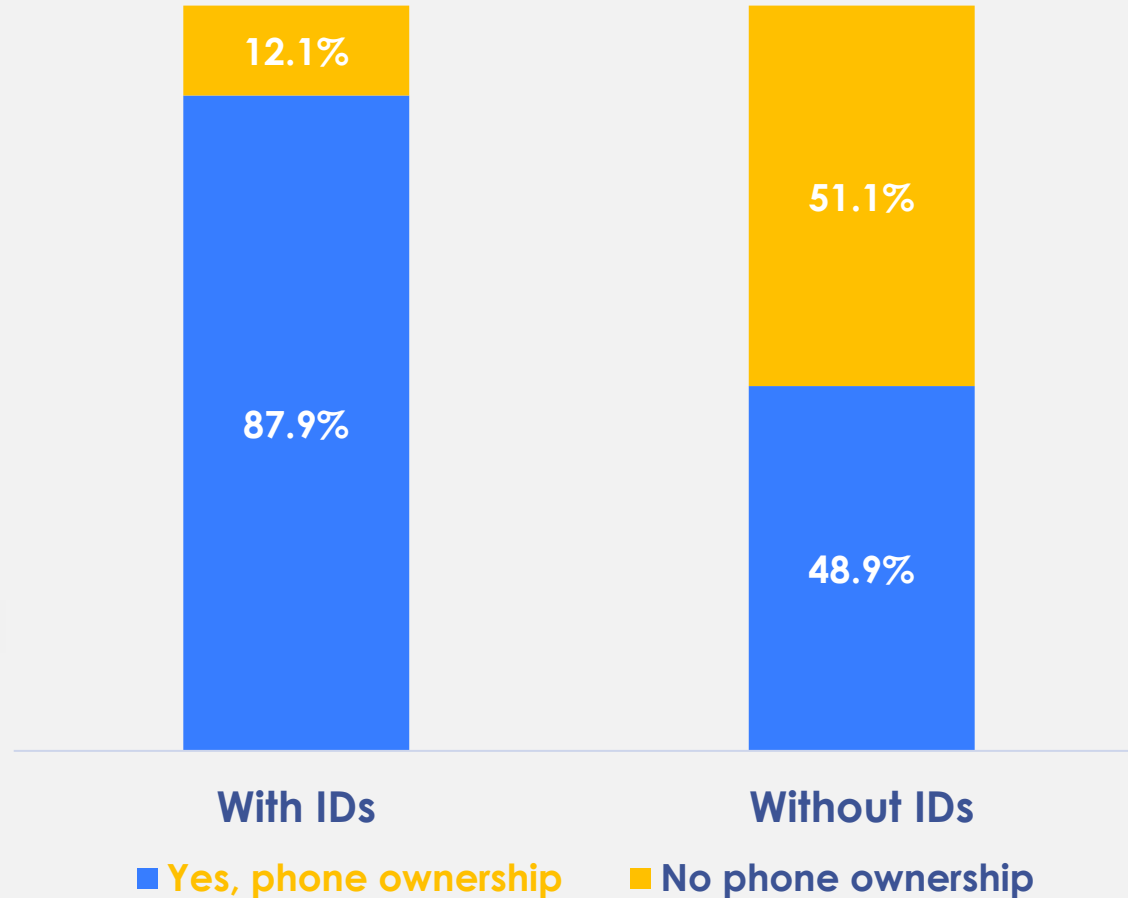
National identity card ownership by county

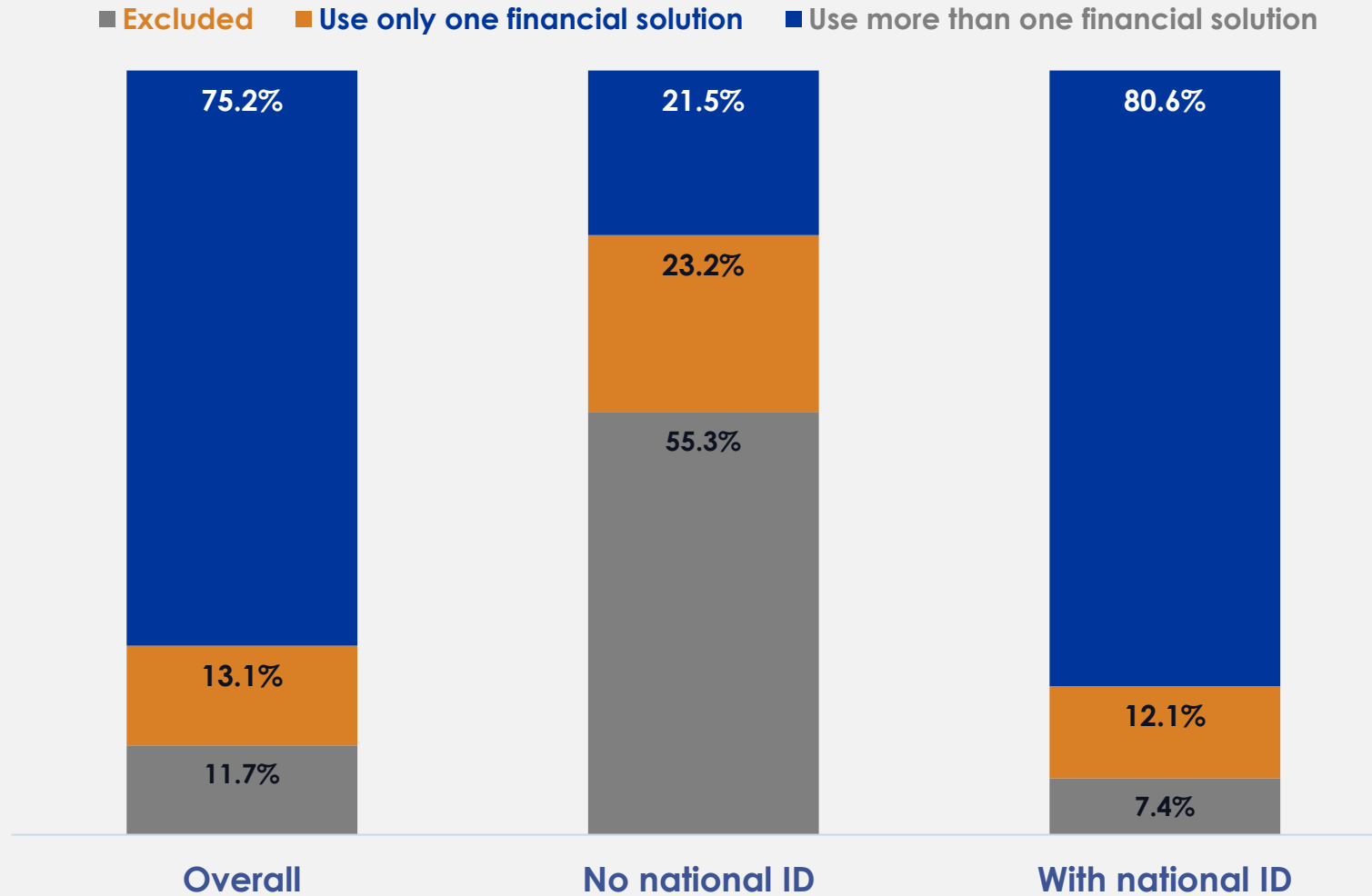

National ID and Phone ownership



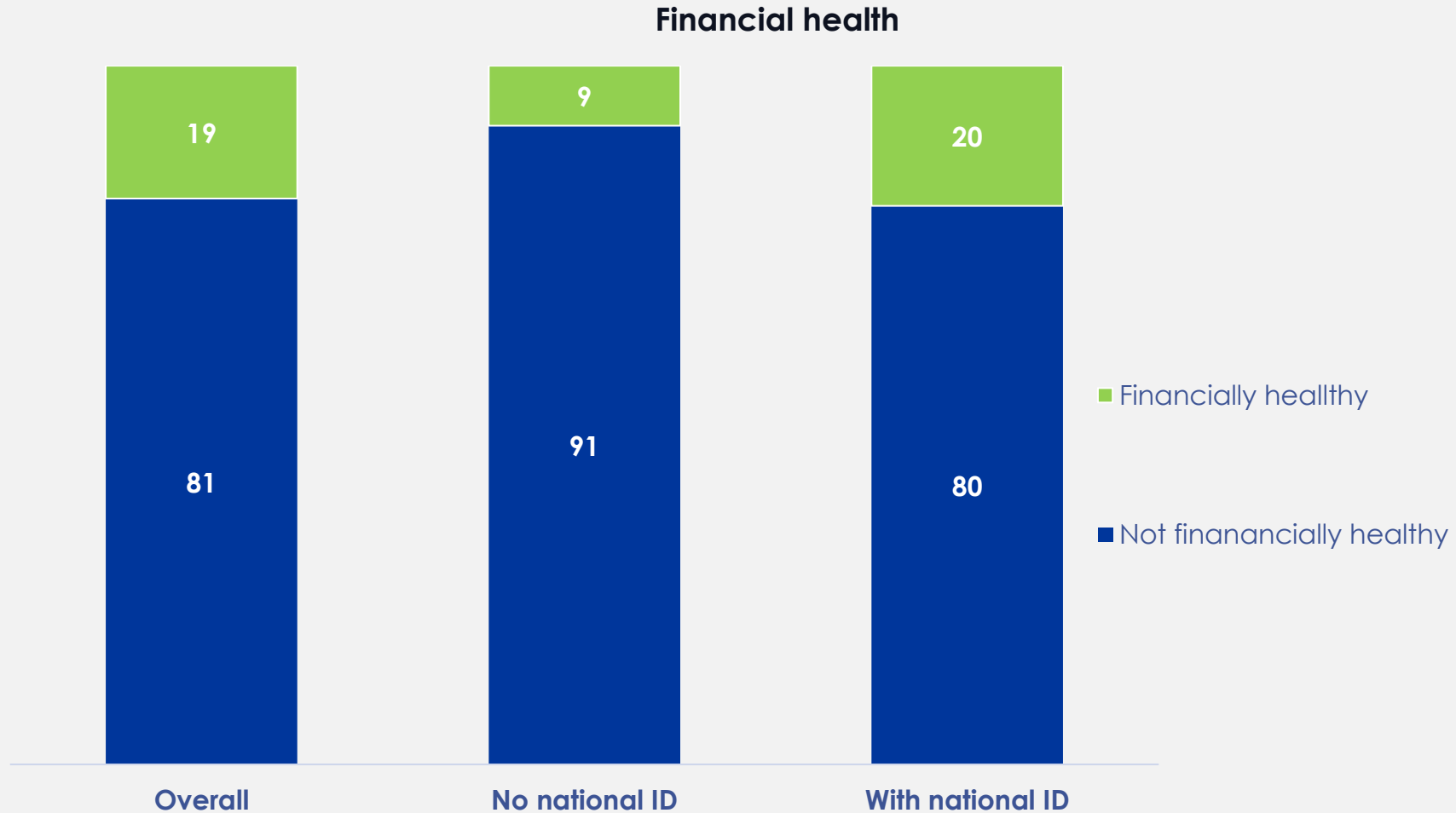

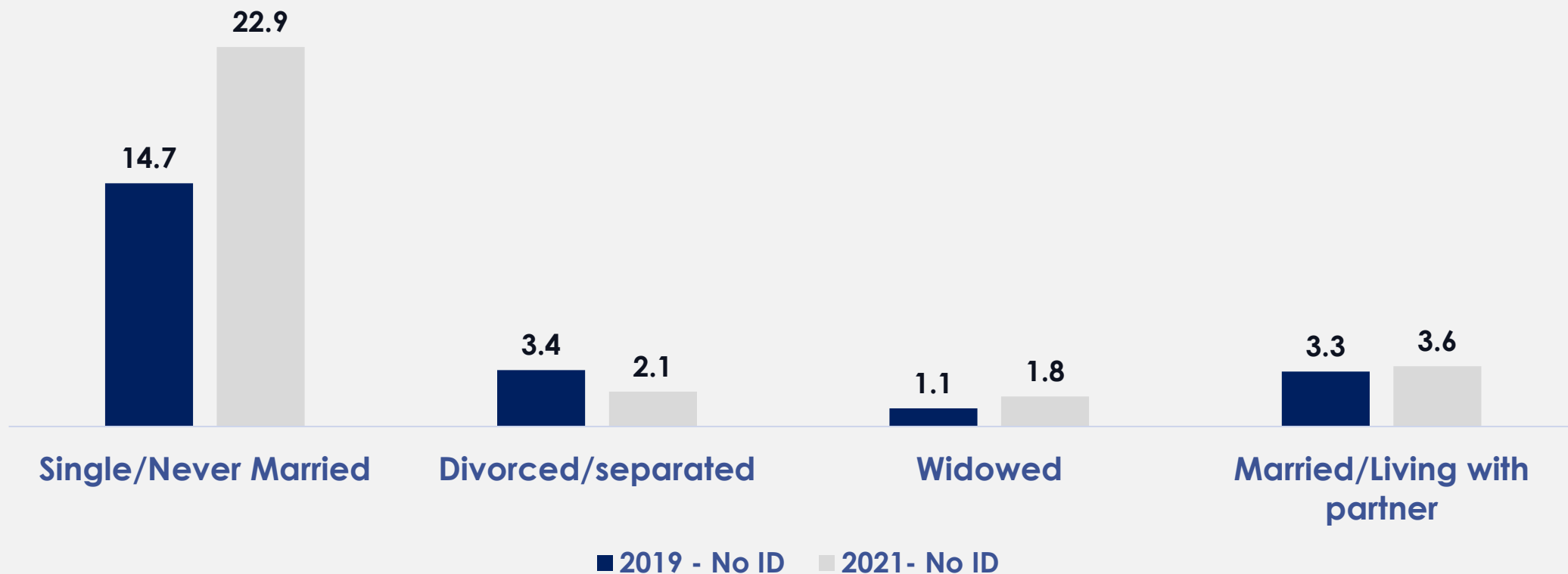

Majority without IDs are single with decline in the lack of IDs among the divorced

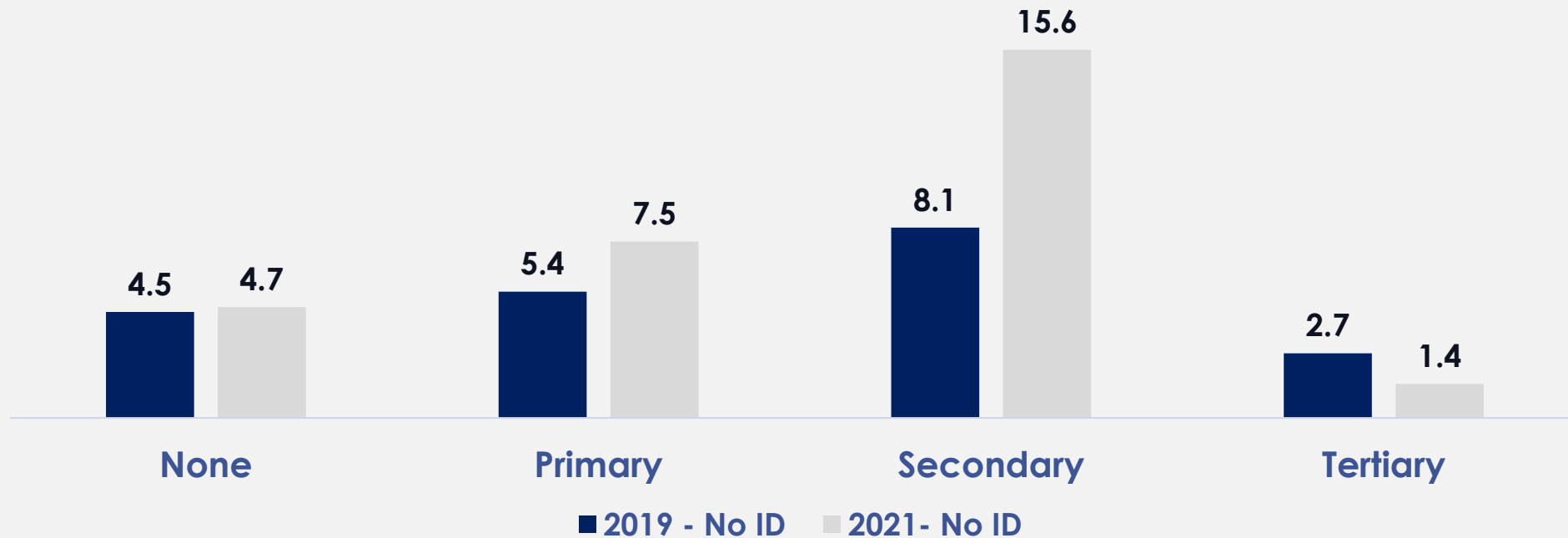
Lack of National Identity cards (2019 and 2021) – marital status

Lack of National Identity cards (2019 and 2021) – Education level



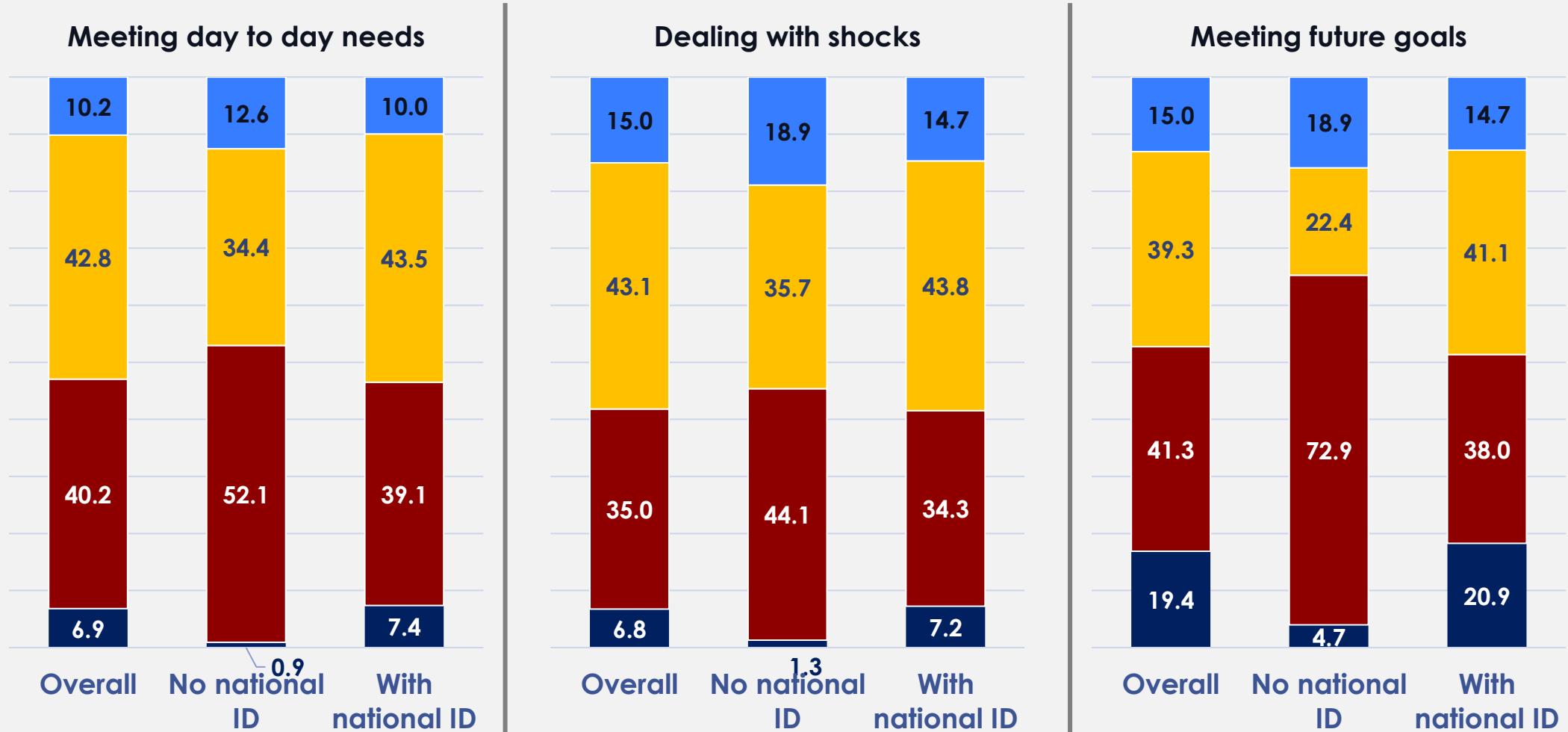
